Intel Programmable Solutions Group is now Altera

Description:

As previously announced in February 2024, Intel Programmable Solutions Group (PSG) was launched as Altera, a standalone FPGA company.

Beginning January 2025, Altera completed its operational transition to a standalone company. Customers are requested to update their systems to convert all former Intel PSG products to Altera Semiconductor Technology Inc.

Despite the transition, many items and functions are expected to remain the same. See below for a summary:

Products and product datasheets	No change
Manufacturing facilities, Bill-of-Materials (BOM), product marking, traceability, and labeling	No change
Ordering Part Numbers (OPNs), shipment process and packing labels	No change
Customer support and service	No change
Customer notification distribution of product or process changes (PCN, PDN, ADV)	No change
Corporate Social Responsibility status and compliance (Material Declaration, RoHS, REACH, Conflict Minerals)	No change
Website	All existing product documentations and customer support tools hosted within the Intel website will continue to be available and will not have immediate changes. Link to the Altera page

Expect to continue seeing the Intel name and logo on certain product top markings, labels, and documents as we work through the rest of the transition to Altera.

For future changes to any of the processes and products as part of the long-term standalone operation, Altera will work closely with customers and issue communications through our Sales team or issue appropriate change notifications in accordance with J-STD-046 (Customer Notification Standard for Product/Process Changes by Electronic Product Suppliers).

Recommended Actions:

Immediate action requested is for customers to update their systems to convert all former Intel PSG products to Altera Semiconductor Technology Inc.

Further actions will be in accordance with future communications and applicable change notifications.
